During the second semester of studies, we focus on learning the print script system. Further groups and sub-categories of verbs in the present tense are examined as well as the infinitive forms. There is a first attempt at dealing with expressing being and possessiveness, as well as time and age.

By the end of this course, student will be able to:
  - Handle the second print system (i.e. print script) with relative ease and read longer texts
  - Conjugate verbs of the *פעל* group in the *ל"י-ל"ה* sub-category as well as regular verbs of the second group *פיעל* in the present
  - Formulate the equivalent infinitive forms of the verbs
  - Express time
  - Express age
  - Structure complex verbal sentences in the affirmative and negative (causal sentences)
